

The Master of Science in Clinical Leadership

The MS in Clinical Leadership is designed for future clinicians who wish to better understand the health care industry and the environment in which it exists or who aspire to clinically-related leadership roles. It gives future clinicians; physicians, pharmacists, and nurse managers, an understanding of the complex business environment in which they will ultimately practice. The degree may enhance the academic record for those who plan to attend medical school.

The twelve course MS in Clinical Leadership degree can be completed in one year on a full-time basis. Joint program students complete the MS degree concurrently with another degree program.
